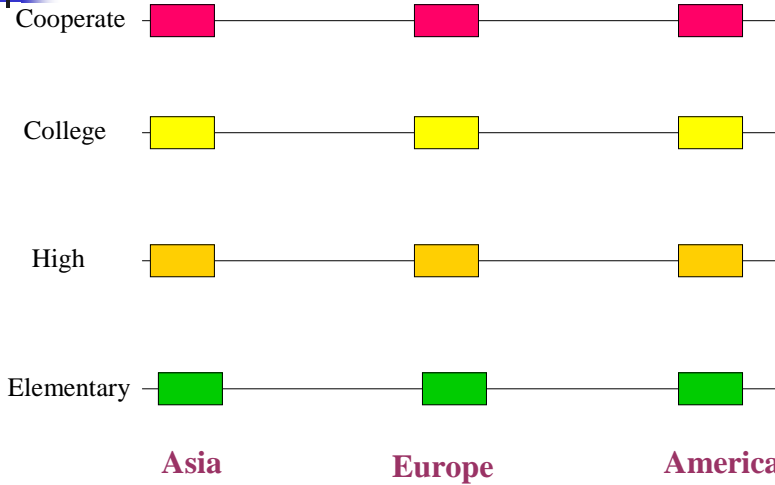

What is G1:1?

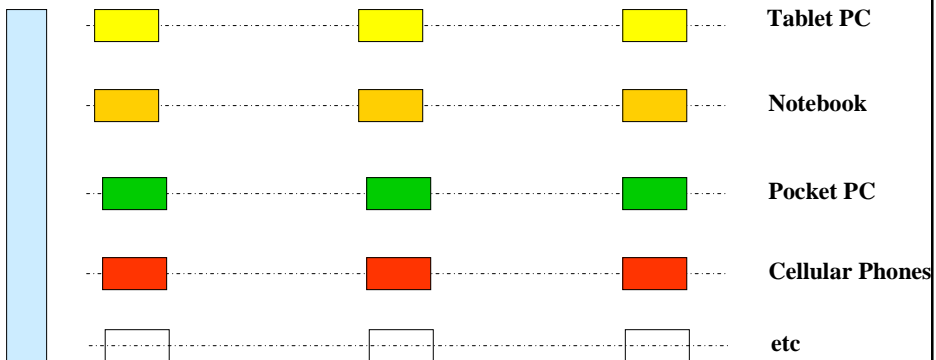
- A network of international researchers

Different Age Groups and Continents



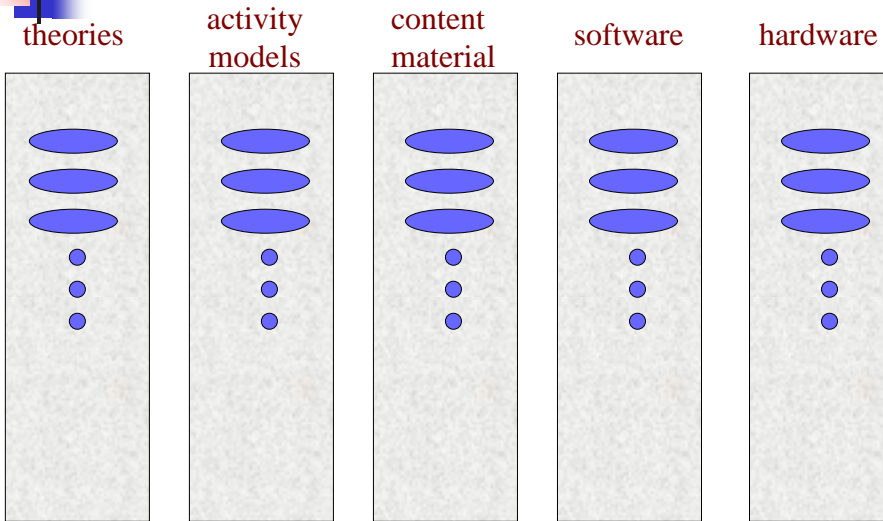
